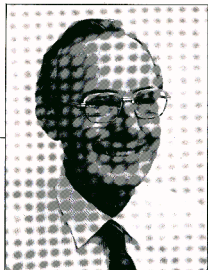

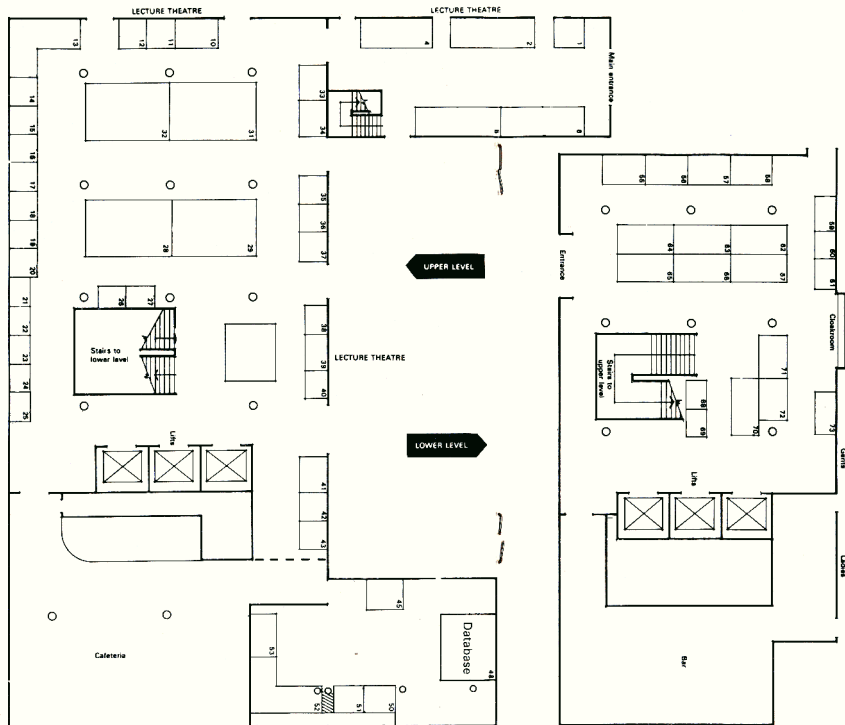

What a difference a year makes...

March 1987

A major overseas order is clinched by Acorn when the Hong Kong government purchases 700 Master 128s.

April 1987

Three new appointments to the board of Acorn are announced. Paolo Tosi and Franco Agostinucci become directors and Bruno Soggiu, Olivetti's vice president for product strategy, is named chairman.

May 1987

The *Micro User* magazine reveals exclusively that Acorn is working on a range of new super-fast 32 bit machines, seven times faster than any micro currently available and based on the revolutionary Risc chip.

June 1987

Acorn announces an operating profit of £1.4 million for 1986 on a turnover of £46.7 million. The company spent £5 million on research and development, most of it allocated to its Risc machine.

July 1987

Archimedes - the world's fastest micro - is launched. The entry level model is 20 times faster than the BBC Micro, and at half a megabyte has a memory capacity 15 times greater.

August 1987

Acorn cuts the prices of its Master

range by an average 15 per cent, but promises to continue supporting the machine fully.

September 1987

Six figure sales within the year are forecast by Acorn for the Archimedes following a flood of advance orders and serious enquiries from the education and business sectors in particular.

October 1987

Acorn dismisses as "just a hiccup" its latest balance sheet which shows a net loss of £1.38 million for the first six months of the year. Investment in development and launch of the Archimedes is blamed for an operating loss of £950,000.

November 1987

Encouraging market response to the Archimedes allows Acorn to cut the machine's price by £100. Bruno Soggiu takes over from Brian Long as managing director of Acorn and announces that an exciting new series of Unix workstations are under development.

December 1987

In a move to forge closer links between Acorn and Olivetti, Filippo Demonte, senior vice president of Olivetti Personal Computers, and Luigi Pistelli, senior vice president of Olivetti Systems and Networks, are appointed to the board of Acorn.

January 1988

Bruno Soggiu, Acorn's new managing

director, announces plans for a new Unix workstation project. This is expected to be a special development of the Risc chip to produce a micro-processor to drive a Unix workstation, a purpose which many believe to be a perfect application for Acorn's state of the art technology.

February 1988

Acorn lays off 49 technical and support staff in what it describes as "a withdrawal from creating custom-made products for individual end users". This means an end to Acorn involvement in expensive endeavours

aimed at limited areas of the marketplace. Instead, the company "is to reorganise its resources so as to take advantage of the positive market reaction to its 32 bit Risc technology".

March 1988

Acorn pulls off a major coup by winning an order from Japan for British computer technology. The company is to install 40 BBC Master 128s linked by Ecomet for the Japanese Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The system will be used to teach English to aspiring diplomats who will eventually work abroad.
